Project Update #4

Construction has been focused on several aspects of the project:

Concrete. The mezzanine slab has been poured and the slab on grade on the east side of the rink for the change rooms has been poured which will allow the mechanical work to proceed.

Masonry. Masonry work is ongoing in various areas within heated space under orange tarps. (see photo #1 below of work in gymnasium)

Structural Framing. All the glulam beams from Structurlam have arrived on site and installation began in mid January. (photo #2 below). Main floor Structural Steel has been installed.

Local Labour. Total hours from August to December was 11,536 with a monthly range between 1616- 2816 hours for 10 to 16 workers from August to December.
